Focus on COVID-19 Vaccine



The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) provides a wealth of **information about the different vaccines** available :

(navigate from the left sidebar)

- · how the vaccines work
- · detailed list of ingredients for each
- · safety information, including allergies & side effects
- · results of clinical trials
- myths and facts about the vaccines (under Key Things to Know)

You can check eligibility for the vaccine, vaccination location sites, and volunteer opportunities to help with the vaccination effort in St. Lawrence County.
